RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE ORGANIZERS

Written Bulletins when issued shall be put up on the Official Notice Board and shall have the same legal force, as the Supplementary Regulations. All Bulletins will be communicated dated and sequentially numbered. These Bulletins shall have the force (and will constitute an integral part) of these regulations and will be posted at the venue.

The Organisers will ensure that all relevant permissions are obtained from the competent authorities prior to the event, copies of which must be made available to the Stewards.

The Organisers will ensure that all monetary fines / penalties collected during the event are

sent to FMSCI at the earliest as per Art 157 of FIA Sporting Code

ENTRIES

Those wishing to take part in the Speed Sprint Zoom 06'14 must send the Entry Form along with the prescribed fee, as per these regulations, duly completed, to the Secretariat. If the entry is sent by facsimile or email the original must reach the Organisers at the latest by 0800 hrs on 13 July, 2014. No amendments may be made to the entry form, except in the cases provided for in the Regulations.

Entries are restricted to a maximum of 4 entries per driver, however the Organisers reserve the right to increase the number with time permitting.

Once an entry has been submitted, no request for change of driver and/or vehicle is permitted

The entry application will be accepted only if accompanied by the entry fees, which will be increased by 500% for those competitors not accepting the optional advertising of the Organisers.

All entrants taking part in the Event must ensure that self-attested copies of the documents detailed in the entry form are submitted at the secretariat of the event in accordance with the timetable of the Event. Any entry reporting to the administrative checks outside the time limits prescribed will not be allowed to start, except in a case of force majeure duly recognised as such by the Stewards.

Should it turn out, at the time of pre-event scrutineering that a vehicle does not correspond in its presentation to the group/ class in which it was entered, this vehicle may, upon the proposal of the Scrutineers, be transferred by the Stewards to a different Group/ Class or be refused definitively. In case the vehicle is transferred to a different group, fees of Rs. 1000/- for change of vehicle will apply.

By the very fact of signing the entry form, the competitor submits to the sporting jurisdictions specified in the Code and these regulations only.

NUMBER OF ENTRIES ACCEPTED AND CLASSES

The maximum number of entries shall be not more than 60. The organisers reserve the right to increase the number. The organizers reserve the right to decide how many and which entries will be accepted.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fees specified is : Registration Fee: INR 1000 plus

Standard Fee INR 500/- : For the first 40 entries

Premium Fee INR 1,000/- : For subsequent entries

Last Day Fee INR 1,500/-

It ONLY includes an opportunity to participate in the Speed Sprint Zoom 06'14, one race FMSCI License and organisers insurance of Rs2,00,000 for Competitors Personal Accident coverage.

TEAM ENTRY

Aggregate best timing of three riders would be taken to form classification. Each team entry will include one invite to the Prize Distribution for the Team Manager. For any additional invites the entrants should contact secretariat.

MANUFACTURERS TEAM ENTRY

For Team entries, in addition to prevailing entry fees Manufacturers & Trade Team Entry: INR 50,000 per team of 3 vehicles.

REFUNDS

Entry fee is NON REFUNDABLE.

Entry fees will be refunded in full ONLY to those candidates whose entry has not been accepted OR In case the Event does not take place. Entry fees will NOT be refunded for ANY OTHER reason.

EVENT

Venue: Delhi NCR, India

Approximate Length : ~4 Kms

Surface : Tarmac

Timing : Timing Beam or Manual

RESULTS

The results of the competition will be based on each competitor's time of the runs completed and any penalties incurred.

TIMING

Timing will be to the nearest second from a standing start to a flying finish. The maximum time allowed to complete the stage is 6 minutes Times will be posted on the official notice board. The location of the official notice board will be the Secretariat located at the Rally Office, Delhi NCR, India

TIES

Ties will be resolved by reference to the fastest time on the last run.

ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

The Speed Sprint Zoom 06'14 is open to all 2 wheeler vehicles in due possession of a valid registration certificate. These vehicles must comply with the safety specifications laid down by the International Convention on Road Traffic, as well as the safety specifications laid down by the FMSCI regulations governing rallies.

VEHICLE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO START UNLESS IT IS EQUIPPED WITH SAFETY REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN THE SPORTING/ TECHNICAL REGULATIONS OF THE FMSCI

- Protective Gear - Gloves, Riding goggles , jacket ,trousers
- Footwear - Imported boots compulsory
- Gloves - Weather proof required
- Helmet - Mandatory, must be any of the following makes, ARAI, BELL, SFI, SNELL, OMP, Sparco or FIA/FIM Approved Or conforming to ECE 22.05 standard. Open face recommended

COMPETITORS

A rider has to have a valid civil driving licence for entering this event.

Any rider holding an FMSCI 2wheeler National Rally competitors license valid for the year 2013 is eligible. The minimum requirement is "One Event" A/B/C competition license @Rs200/-

or 2 wheeler Full Rally Competition License @Rs1100/-

If entrant is different from that of the first named rider or is a team then FMSCI entrant license is a must

Navigator / Co-Driver is NOT permitted.

GROUPS & CLASSES

The Speed Sprint Zoom 06'14 will have following groups and class.

1. Modified or Stock bikes in following classes
 - a. upto 135cc
 - b. upto 165cc
 - c. upto 165cc
 - d. upto 250cc
 - e. above 250cc
2. Local open
3. Novice open

In case a group is not formed then the entries will only compete for overall classification. A group will not be formed if there are fewer than four entries registered. There shall be NO amalgamation of Groups.

In case a class if not formed it will be merged with the higher class. A higher class will not be merged with lower class. A class will not be formed if there are fewer than four entries registered.

IDENTIFICATION

The organisers will supply each crew with identification plates comprising: 2 rally plates, the plates must be affixed in conformity of the supplementary regulations. These would be affixed on both sides of the vehicle throughout the duration of the Event

The member of the crew will be recognisable by means of an identification tag to be worn throughout the event. Any breach noted by an official will result in a cash penalty of INR 3,000/-. The blood group & emergency number must be written on this tag.

SCRUTINEERING, SEALING & MARKING

Only those riders who have passed the administrative checks may present themselves with their vehicle equipped with its plates and numbers at scrutineering.

Competitors not conforming to the norms would be automatically disqualified and their entry fees would be forfeited. No vehicle will be allowed to start unless it complies with the FIM / FMSCI safety regulations and the present Prescriptions.

The scrutineering card must be carried in the vehicle throughout the event. This scrutineering card must be produced to any official on demand and surrendered at the finish.

Loss of the scrutineering card may result in exclusion.

The rider has to present the vehicle for scrutiny personally and not through representative. In case of one vehicle being shared by multiple drivers the same may be presented for scrutiny by any one of the drivers.

No vehicle is allowed to be driven, from the start till end of the event, by any other person than the registered rider at pain of exclusion.

RIDERS BRIEFING

A general briefing will be held as per itinerary. All competitors need to sign their presence in the register maintained at the venue for this purpose. Absence of signature will be deemed as absence at the briefing and sanctions would apply as the presence of driver is compulsory on pain of exclusion

CEREMONIAL FLAG OFF

A ceremonial flag off may be held at the start venue. It is compulsory for all drivers to take part in the ceremonial flag off at pain of sanctions which may include exclusion. After the flag off, all vehicles will follow a timed transport itinerary to the holding area.

RECCONIASANCE

A general recce of one lap of the track would be allowed per vehicle irrespective of the number of entries made or drivers using the vehicle. It is not mandatory to undertake the recce.

RACE CARDS

At the Start of the event, a race cards shall be issued to each competitor. At each race the competitor shall hand over his race card to the time control. Each crew is solely responsible for his/her race card. Any changes or amendment made to the card will result in exclusion, unless such correction or amendment has been approved in writing by the controller.

The crew alone is responsible for submitting the race card at the different controls and for the accuracy of the entries. The controllers are the only persons allowed to enter the time on the time card, by hand or by means of a print-out.

The loss of a Time Card will entail exclusion.

RACE

Races shall start with opening of race gate and will cease with closing of race gate. It is competitors sole responsibility to ensure that he joins the start line in time for all his race cards.

The exact time of crossing the Flying Finish will be timed to the second. After completion of all

racers, all vehicles will remain parked in parc ferme.

A vehicle must enter the race area by its own means, with the engine running; moving under the power of the starter-motor alone is not allowed

It is forbidden, under pain of exclusion:

- 1. To drive in the opposite direction***
- 2. To transport vehicles except under their own power and driven by registered driver.***
- 3. Deliberately to block the passage of the vehicles, or to prevent them from overtaking.***
- 4. To behave in any unsporting manner.***

The wearing of safety harnesses is compulsory throughout the Event including all road sections.

Under the Laws of India any accident out of which a claim may arise should be reported to the nearest police station.

Any competitor involved in an accident which results in physical harm will be subject to an investigation by the Jury of Sporting Stewards. Depending on the circumstances, penalties may be applied in form of time or Cash, including disqualification.

PRACTICE

No practice will be allowed

GENERAL

A starter is any driver having passed scrutineering and crossed the start line in practice under the power of his car's engine.

Re-runs will be permitted only when a red flag has been shown during the race.

All other incidents will be treated as "force majeure".

If a driver in a qualifying deliberately causes a re-run by crowding or obstruction, the driver concerned may be excluded, at the Stewards' discretion.

STOPPING THE RACE:

See Article 18 of the General Prescriptions of the Code.

START

Timing will be by Stop Watches or electronic beams, to one tenth of a second.

FALSE STARTS

Judges of fact will be appointed to determine false starts in case of manual countdown or, where available, electronic beams may be used. In case of any false start the competitor will be adjudged DNF and lose his round in which such false start takes place.

FLAG SIGNALS

Flag signals in conformity with Appendix H to the Code will be used.
All drivers will immediately stop racing and return to start gate if a RED flag is displayed

ASSISTANCE

IS AUTHORISED AT

Repairs are authorised at all times only in the designated service/ holding area, or any other area indicated in these regulations.

IS FORBIDDEN AT

RACE AREA IS DESIGNATED AS UNSUITABLE FOR ASSISTANCE VEHICLES.

Assistance between competitors in the race area is not allowed.

Any vehicle towed and / or pushed by means other than a organiser/authorised vehicle is deemed DNF for the applicable round. Any official may move the vehicle away from the racing track in case it is judged to be obstructing the passage of other competitors.

CONTROL ZONES

All controls, i.e. Time Controls at start and finish of Competitive Section, will be indicated by means of standardized signs of FMSCI/ FIA. The stopping time within any control area must not exceed the time necessary for carrying out control operations. It is strictly forbidden to enter or leave a control area from any direction other than that prescribed by the itinerary of the Event or to re-enter a control area once checking in has taken place at this control. Any infringement will result in exclusion.

The Official Time throughout the entire rally will be Indian Standard Time expressed by GPS Time in accordance with the 24 hour clock. Hours and minutes & seconds will be shown thus e.g. 22:01:46

The Start at the Section will be given with a Manual Count Down or signal lights. At the End of section the time would be recorded at the moment the vehicles crosses the Flying Finish line.

INSURANCE

ONLY DURING THE RUNNING OF THE EVENT ,

- 150 COMPETITORS WITH VALID FMSCI COMPETITION LICENCE ARE COVERED FOR Rs.5 LACS PERSONAL ACCIDENT & Rs.1 LAC TOWARDS MEDICAL EXPENSES.
- 100 OFFICIALS ARE COVERED FOR Rs.25 LACS (PERSONAL ACCIDENT) & Rs.1 LAC TOWARDS MEDICAL EXPENSES.
- THIRD PARTY PUBLIC LIABILITY FOR RS.50 LAKHS

THESE INSURANCES ARE ISSUED BY THE ORIENTAL INSURANCE COMPANY LTD VALID DURING THE RUNNING OF THE EVENT ONLY.

All competitors are required to take a further mandatory personal accident insurance for Rs.2,00,000/- each including hospitalization benefits. This insurance should not be normal insurance, but specifically "High Risk" insurance.

The insurance of each vehicle against Third Party risk is the minimum requirement as per the Laws in India.

COMPETITORS ATTENTION IS PARTICULARLY DRAWN TO THE FACT THAT NORMAL MOTOR POLICIES ISSUED IN INDIA DO NOT PROVIDE COVER FOR RALLYING

PROTESTS & APPEALS

All protests must be made in accordance with the rules laid down by the FMSCI & the International Sporting Code. They must be made in writing and given to the CRO / COC, accompanied by the sum of Rs2000/- which will be retained if the protest is not considered justified.

The appeal fee as set by FMSCI is Rs 80,000/- with Rs 40,000/- to be paid along-with intention to appeal, within 1 hour of the stewards decision and balance Rs.40,000/- with grounds of appeal within 48 hours.

3. Absence of 1 Rally Number/Plate : INR 3,000
4. Absence of 2 Rally Number/Plate : INR 10,000
5. Missing ID Tag : INR 3,000
6. Improper Advertising : INR 3,000 to 10,000
7. Non-Reporting for Admin Check : Exclusion
8. Non-Reporting at Scrutiny : Exclusion
9. Unsporting Behaviour : Exclusion
10. Not Wearing Seat Belts/Helmets : Exclusion
11. Causing Injury/Rash & Negligent Behaviour : Exclusion
12. Failure to Hand over Time Card at control : Exclusion
13. Late at Start of Event/ Round : 1minute for every minute late
14. Late at start by 10 minutes : Exclusion
15. Loss of Time Card : Exclusion
16. Failure to start within 20 sec. of Start Signal : Exclusion
17. False Start : Exclusion
18. Not Stopping at or before Stop Sign : Exclusion
19. Infringements of Parc Fermé Regulations : Exclusion

PRIZES TROPHIES

OVERALL FASTEST : Trophy for Rider

Trophy for first and second in each group

TEAM PRIZE : Trophy for Team

The Organizers may at their discretion offer awards in addition to those specified in these Supplementary Regulations.

Distribute the awards, if through unforeseen or special circumstances; the competition is stopped before its scheduled completion.

ADVERTISING

Competitors are allowed to affix any kind of advertising to their vehicles, provided that:

Any instructions issued by the organisers are observed. Advertising must not be of a political, obscene or insulting nature. It must be in good taste and not conflict with the vehicles official numbers in any way

It should not be placed as to prevent recognition by Officials or Marshals.

The front doors shall be left free of advertising other than that provided by the organisers.

it does not encroach upon the spaces reserved for compulsory advertisements and it does not interfere with the crew's vision through the windows. Space required as indicated in these regulations must be left free of advertising other than that provided by the organisers. Advertising provided by the organisers must be carried & placed ONLY as indicated in the diagram below.

The crews will ensure that the advertising is properly affixed through the running of the event. If compulsory or optional advertising is absent or wrongly fixed, a penalty of INR 3,000/- will be incurred for a first offence and INR 10,000/-for each repeated offence.

Any competitor carrying advertising relating to a make/model of a vehicle, make of tyre, fuel or lubricant will be deemed as commercial. Such entry will pay an increase of 500% of the entry fee.
